Woodman Avenue Median Retrofit Project



Meeting sponsored by the Panorama City Neighborhood Council, Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, Department of Public Works, and The River Project.

WHAT: Review the Draft Design Plan of the *Woodman Avenue Stormwater Capture and Median Retrofit Project* and provide input to the project team.

Project Description: The project, part of the Tujunga/Pacoima Watershed Plan, will retrofit the 3,500 foot long concrete median running along the west side of Woodman Avenue from Lanark Street to Saticoy Street in order to recharge the groundwater basin, improve water quality, alleviate local flooding and enhance the community. The project will capture surface stormwater that currently flows into the Los Angeles River and out to the ocean. Flows will be re-directed into a naturalized vegetated swale for infiltration. Construction is scheduled to begin mid-January 2012 and be complete by late October 2012.
